TIPS TO SAVE MONEY ON DIAPERS:

- Buy your diapers at Target when they offer a giftcard with a certain purchase
- Use a Redcard to get an additional 5% off
- Ship them to your house for free
- Keep the receipt taped to the box
- Use higher quality diapers at night (Pamper's Baby Dry / Aldi's Little Journey) and cheaper ones during the day
- Stock up when they are on sale

Diapers Rule of Thumb:

Newborn: 0.12

Size 1: 0.10

Size 2: 0.11

Size 3: 0.12

Size 4: 0.13

Size 5: 0.14

Size 6: 0.15

Wipes: Less than 0.02 each

TIPS TO SAVE MONEY ON FORMULA:

- Buy your formula at Sam's Club or Costco (non-GMO)
- If possible, buy powder formulation
- · Other tips: buy store brand tylenol (for children, dye free), babysitting co-op
